

## The Answer II – Cast Listing



John Morgan, is the husband of Kathy, and a father to two. John owns a Tool & Dye making business... With a downturn in contracts to fulfill present quotas, and with some supply chain issues, he has had to write credit checks in order to keep good workers, hoping that more contracts will come in for fulfillment. He sells a boat, a motorcycle, a specialty car, and lets some of his memberships expire to keep things afloat. Because of Kathy's faith, and their discussions, he now, in his sleep, has dreams of how to increase his business, and acts upon the contents of those dreams. One such dream includes a merger with his competitor on the other side of town. John is having a very hard time coping with the fact that his daughter, Erica, whom he was so close to, and invested in, is now hooked on drugs. He is in his late forties and has a Choleric/Sanguine personality. Sings (4) songs; Tenor or Baritone. "Hard Times", "What Is New", "This Presence Thing", and "To Know You".

KATYHY, is John's wife. She is in her middle forties and has an analytical personality. She has recently been laid off of her job in management. Her newly restored faith gives her strength and wisdom to deal with her daughter's drug addiction and angst. Her daughter, Erica, is suspected of stealing from her parents to help support her drug habit. She and Erica have an all-out mother/daughter fight. She confronts Erica about her stealing, her grades, her drug addiction; and her future. Kathy and John discuss the predicament of her niece, Amy, whom is now separated from her husband, and is not sure where she and her daughters will go from here. They take Amy and her two daughters into their home for a while. Jennifer finds fulfillment as a stay-athome mom. Because of her skills, she is able to work from home. Kathy's spiritual past and present is discussed and becomes an encouragement, especially with her husband. She reveals the secret to finding the presence of God. Kathy prays for and finds an amazingly wonderful new social network for Erica. Sings on (5) songs; is a Soprano.

ERICA, is the Morgan's daughter. She is in her freshman year of college and is hooked on drugs. Her scholarship to a major university is now being threatened by her addiction.... She is confronted by her mother about her stealing from them to support her drug habit. With much prayer and faith, she is nearly and instantly delivered from drugs and becomes an enthusiastic Christian and a great emotional support for Amy. We must see this range. She has a Sanguine/Choleric personality, and sings (1) song.

LOGAN, is the Morgan's 12-year-old son who is the keeper of the new family Dog, (if you choose to include one), and has contingency lines. He expresses that it's great to have Mom at home! Sings along on one song.

AMY - is the older Niece of Kathy. (Her parents live very far away) She is separated from her husband, Josh. Amy and her daughter, Sophie, and Tricia are temporarily living in the Morgan's house. She exposes why Josh has turned to drugs and how it has affected the family. She has an Analytical/Amiable personality. Because of the testimony and transformation of Erica, she is greatly encouraged, and now has more faith that Josh could experience the same. She sings (2) partial songs with Sophie and Josh.

SOPHIE is the ten/eleven-year-old daughter of Amy. For a time, she is present as discussion is revealed in great detail with Kathy about Jason's addiction. She adds some to the conversation and because she misses her daddy, she sings one short song (song is optional) about her experiences and hopes for the future. We see, hear, and experience this child's pain; up close. Just like her father Josh, she has an expressive Sanguine personality. (Song) "My Daddy Knows What To Do"

TRICIA, is a five/six-year-old daughter of Amy. She has moments where she asks important questions for Grandma. Sings on one group song.

JOSH – Is separated from his wife, Amy, and daughters. He was a very successful Diesel mechanic and made a fine six figure income. Partly because of his overtime and sometimes double time pay, he and his buddies had extra financial resource to be involved in drug addiction. Because of his powerful Sanguine personality, he was able to hide it for a long time. He was eventually, let go from his job, when he failed two routine drug tests. He and Amy almost lose their beautiful home, and this is where he and Amy became separated. He lives in a low-income housing unit among extended stay workers. He was able to keep his diesel pickup truck because of finding some very part time work. He is in a drug counseling program where he eventually reaches out to THE RECOVERY NETWORK. It is here where Josh asks God to free him from his addiction. Because of his faith and sincerity, he experiences a lasting recovery. In the last scene before he sings the DREAMING (Reprise), Josh communicates how that both the natural and the Supernatural were involved in his recovery. Josh sings (6) songs and is a tenor.

AUSTIN – Is a counselor from THE RECOVERY NETWORK. Austin meets Josh for the first time at a Recovery meeting. Josh requests to meet with him at his (Josh's) residence. Austin is there to first listen to him; then to council and pray with him. Austin helps Josh to completely understand that at the core of his recovery, there has to be a Spiritual Transformation.

NICOLE - Is Amy's best friend and because she knows both Josh and Amy, she becomes a link to their reunion. While Amy lives at the Morgan home, Nicole connects the spiritual dots for Amy, leading her to the Lord.

GRANDMA – lives nearby and often comes to the home. She provides teaching moments for the kids.

Dancers and Chorus Singers fill out the opening song; and other scenes.
